

## LESSON 2: ONE WORLD

Today we will learn that we have a big family of brothers and sisters around the world. Here's what we are going to do today:

### 1. WELCOME.

You can use these words, or your own welcome. >> *"Welcome everyone! Today, we are going to talk about how Christians are one big family around the world."*

### 2. WATCH.

### 3. REFLECT.

Depending on the age of your kids, use the following questions to have a short discussion. If your kids are younger, choose just one question that you think will engage them. There are no "right" answers here. Encourage the kids to think about their faith, and share your own faith with them!

#### Today's discussion questions:

1. Do you know anyone who was born or lived in another country?
2. Do you want to travel to another country? Where would you go?
3. What are some things that you can do to share your love with your brothers and sisters in Christ in other countries?

### 4. PRACTICE.

Practice the memory verse together. >> *We love because he first loved us. —1 John 4:19*

### 5. PRAY.

Use this prayer or your own. >> *"Dear God, thank you for giving us brothers and sisters around the world. Help us to share your love around the world. Amen."*

### 6. DO.

Follow the directions for today's craft. >> *Today, we are going to make a world!*

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#### **If you have more time:**

- After the discussion, enjoy this silly song about being one family in Christ: <https://youtu.be/beV-hnr122w>
- Play a game: Follow the leader. Form a line. The first person in line is the leader. As the leader walks around, he or she should do actions, like waving their hands, or kicking out their legs. The kids behind the leader should copy what the leader does.



## LESSON 2: ONE WORLD CRAFT INSTRUCTIONS

Today, we are going to make **a world!**

### **SUPPLIES:**

- Cardstock pages (one for each child)
- Craft glue
- Blue and green tissue paper, cut into approximately 2" x 2" squares
- Pencils
- Colored pencils, crayons, or markers

### **INSTRUCTIONS:**

#### **Before the lesson:**

- Print the provided globe onto cardstock (one for each child).
- Cut tissue paper into 2" x 2" squares.
- Set out pages so that each child has one. Set out glue and tissue paper so that each child can reach it.

#### **During the lesson:**

1. Give each child a printed globe.
2. Spread glue over each globe (depending on the age of your children, this could be done by an adult/helper, or something that the child can do).
3. The child should scrunch up the paper square and glue it on the globe. The kids can use green and blue paper to make a map (grouping green together to make land, and blue together to make an ocean).  
*Pro Tip:* Wrap the tissue paper square around the eraser end of a pencil and stick the end onto the paper. Remove the pencil and repeat! You can also dip the base of the pencil (covered by the tissue paper square) into the craft glue as you go, rather than spread glue over the entire globe.
4. For a simpler project, use this page as a coloring page and let the children color the globe with colored pencils, crayons, or markers.
