


PRINTABLE NATIVITY SET

When crafting with kids of any age, the first step is to relax and let them enjoy the craft. If they like to scribble, let them scribble. It's okay if the shepherds have green faces. If your kids run out of energy for coloring, you can still cut it out and set it up. It's designed to look great, even if it isn't colored in.


- 1. This nativity can be printed on regular printer paper. If you want it to be more sturdy, glue the figures onto toilet paper rolls or construction paper.
- 2. To make the stable stand up, glue the back piece onto cardstock or a cereal box and then cut it out.
- 3. Your kids can use crayons, markers, watercolor, or colored pencils on the figures—anything that they like to use. We recommend cutting out after they color.
- 4. Fold on the dotted lines and cut on the bold lines. Glue or tape where the pieces are marked.









